**BAPTISMS:**

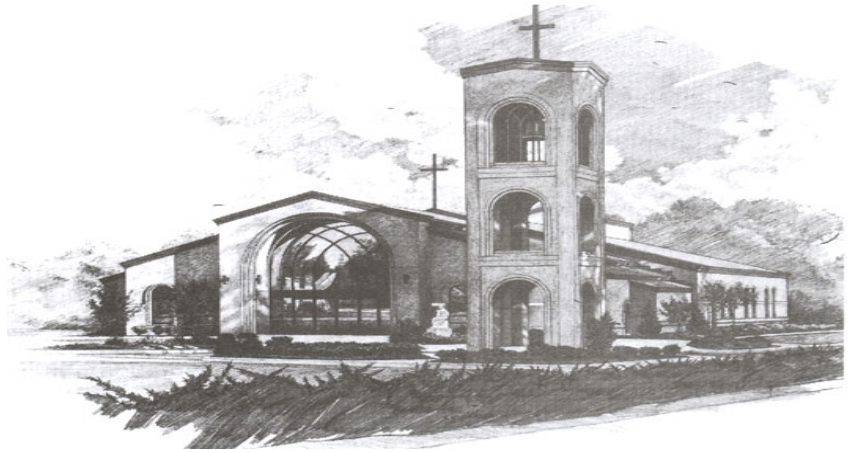
Baptisms are held on Sunday afternoons at 12:30 PM. Arrangements must be made in advance. Godparents are expected to be practicing Catholics. Godparents from other parishes are asked to obtain a letter from their parish priest indicating that they are practicing Catholics. A baptized Christian can serve as a Christian witness for Baptism in place of one of the Godparents.

**MARRIAGES:**

Arrangements must be made at least six months in advance. Participation at Pre-Cana Conference or the Engaged Encounter Weekend is required.

**CCD CLASSES:**

Classes for Grades 1 thru 4 are held on Sunday mornings. Classes for Grades 5 thru 8 are held on Wednesday evenings.

Catholic School 2017-2018 Tuition Assistance Online Application Process Open Families interested in applying for tuition assistance to attend an eligible Diocese of Metuchen Catholic Elementary or high school may do so beginning January 30, 2017. The application process is online through FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment. Online applications must be completed (including supporting documentation) by no later than Friday March 31, 2017. Applications are available in English and Spanish. Families that need assistance completing the online application, or need access to the technology to apply, may register for one of five Application Workshops, which will be held in 4 locations within the Diocese in February and March by going to [www.diomentuchen.org/tuition-assistance](http://www.diomentuchen.org/tuition-assistance) and following the Workshop link.
